- \$53 million annual research expenditure
- 804 articles published annually (Web of Science, 2023)

Versioning

- Metadata about version of record
- Multiple other versions linked in IR
- Challenge for IR manager
- Concern for some of our faculty
- What is responsibility of institution in managing versions to maintain integrity?

Institutional Repository

Only two papers taken down for research integrity issues

1. Accidentally published twice
2. Serious research misconduct

Is there more? What are we missing?

Office of Research

- Investigates fewer than ten allegations of research misconduct annually
- Most of these don't require any mitigation

Data Sets

- Concern about ability to alter data sets we host
- VPR mandates a second copy on local hard drive for longitudinal studies
